

# CMST 255 : Podcast Series Production (Arts and Culture)

**Credits** 5

**Quarter Offered** Spring

This student-run course builds on [CMST 150](#) and is ideal for self-motivated individuals who want to learn and practice the process of producing a podcast series, from planning to publishing, with an emphasis on effective collaboration, management, story judgment, interviewing, editing, and design. Students will produce this arts podcast series, designing its structure and style, by supervising its quarterly publication which examines society from a critical perspective, specifically in the areas of art and culture. This class may include students from multiple sections. (Elective)
