- 3. Evaluate the main competitors: distinguish what they do well and what they do poorly.
- 4. Develop competitive advantages for a specific business.
- 5. Create a simple profit and loss projection.
- 6. Formulate the breakeven point.
- 7. Evaluate the two primary sources of financing.
