

HUMDV 100: PORTFOLIO PRIOR LEARNING

Student knowledge and skills related to course outcomes are documented in a portfolio for one or more specified courses. The portfolio is reviewed and approved for credit by program faculty and identified administrators.

Course Student Learning Outcomes

1. Develop an introduction to the Portfolio that includes a Vision Statement (description of a long range education and career plan) and a mission statement of the purpose for doing this portfolio.
2. Organize a written autobiography of work history in the field in a chronological or other relevant order, including reflections of professional growth and development.
3. Provide documentation of knowledge, skills and abilities based on course outcomes and/or instructor/program requirements.
4. Produce a printed Portfolio that includes documentation as required (certificates, transcripts, photos, course descriptions, journal experiences, artifacts) for presentation to Portfolio evaluators.
